Niffer (Lead Guitar & Vocals) Born and raised in West Wales, on a diet of punk, metal and horror films. Niffer toured as part of the legendary crusty punk band Mugwampjism and has spent the rest of his life trying to channel the ghost of GG Allin.

Harold (Drums & Backing Vocals) From Machynlleth in mid Wales Harold Grew up listening to Queen and then discovering The Sex Pistols and The Clash. Harold played in lots of local bands in the late 90s but found most success with *3 Minute Warning* - a ska/punk band that signed to Do The Dog Music in 2006. Harold has toured through the UK, Ireland and mainland Europe with various bands, and he is also the current UK touring Drummer with NYC Ska legends The Toasters. It's with The Red Bastards that he is fully committed and really enjoying his music. Hoping to push the band on to greater things.

Matt (Bass) Born during a storm some 40 years ago in an unpronounceable town, he spent his days eating crispy pancakes and listening to punk, grunge and heavy metal. Matt has been in many bands over the last 20 years including *3 Minute Warning* & *Cartoon Violence*, recording several albums and going off on many tours of the UK and Europe.
